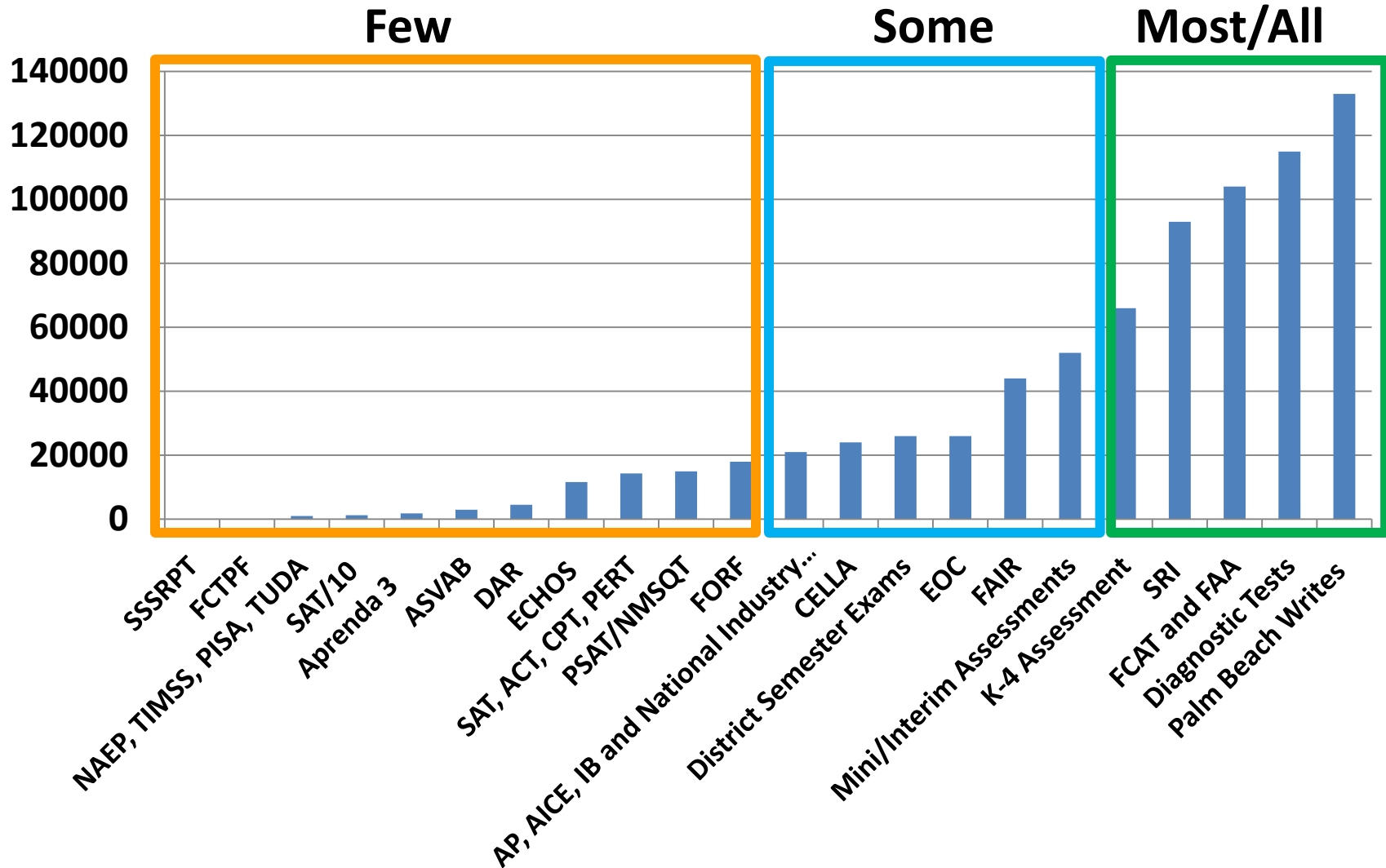

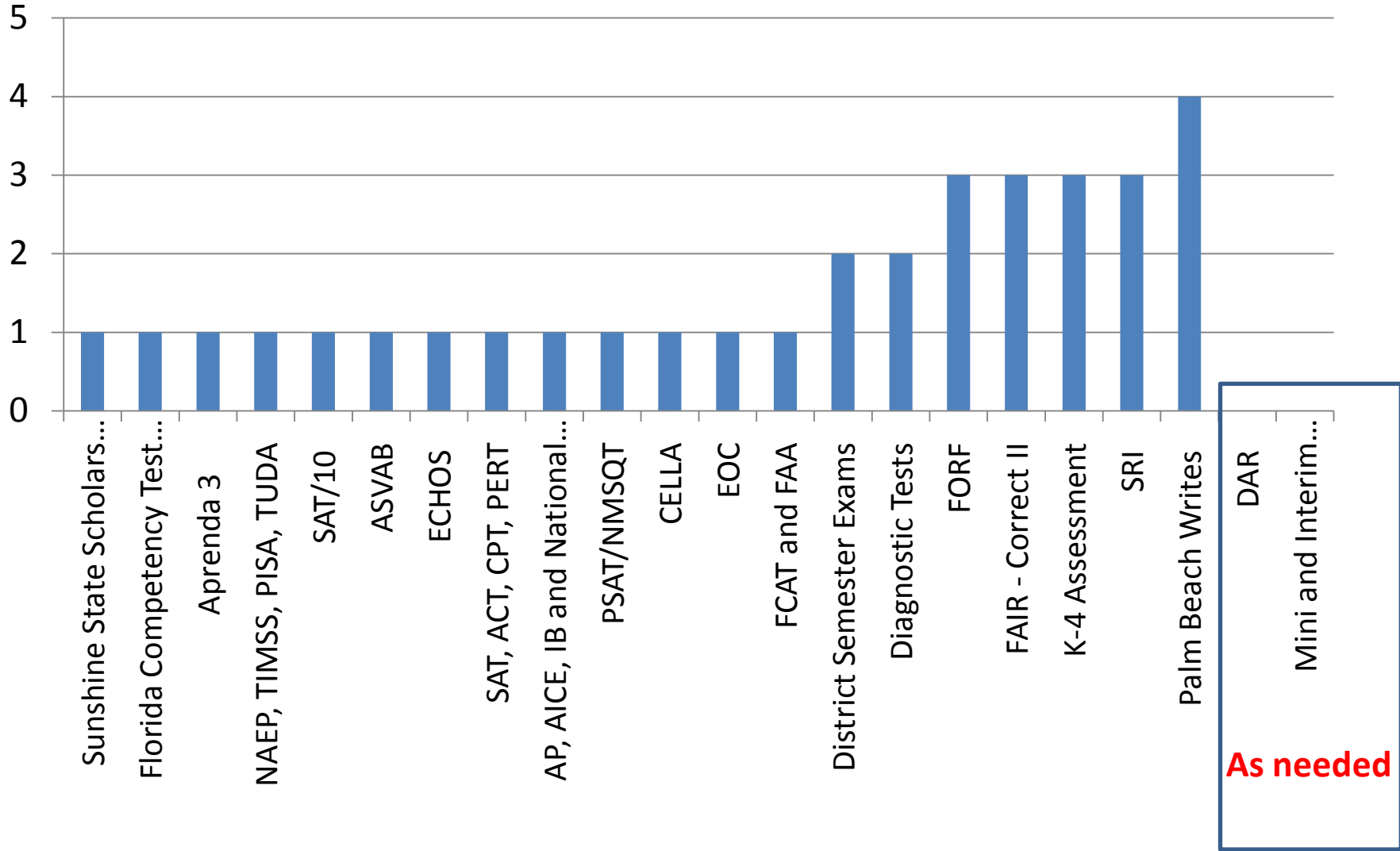

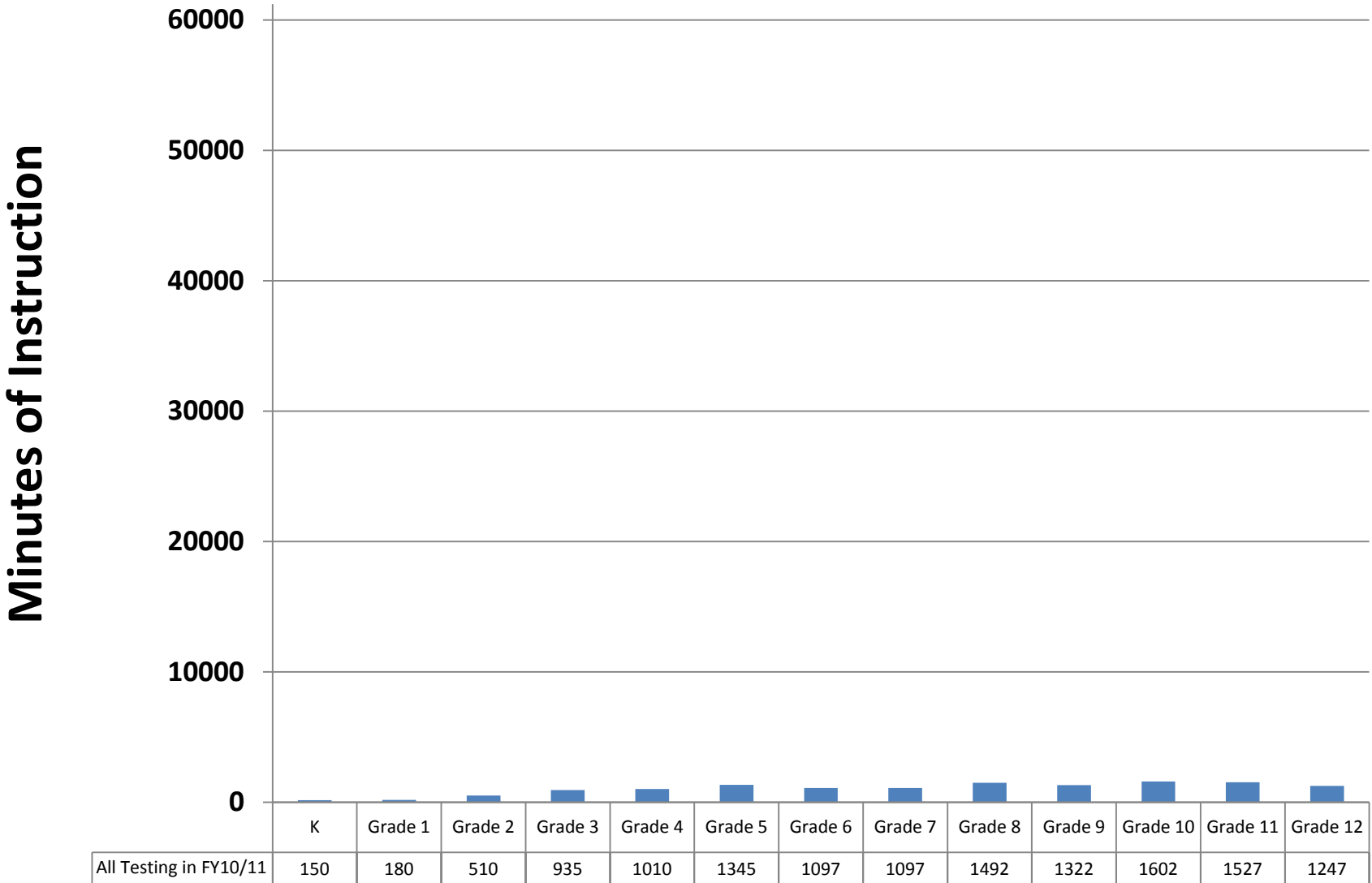

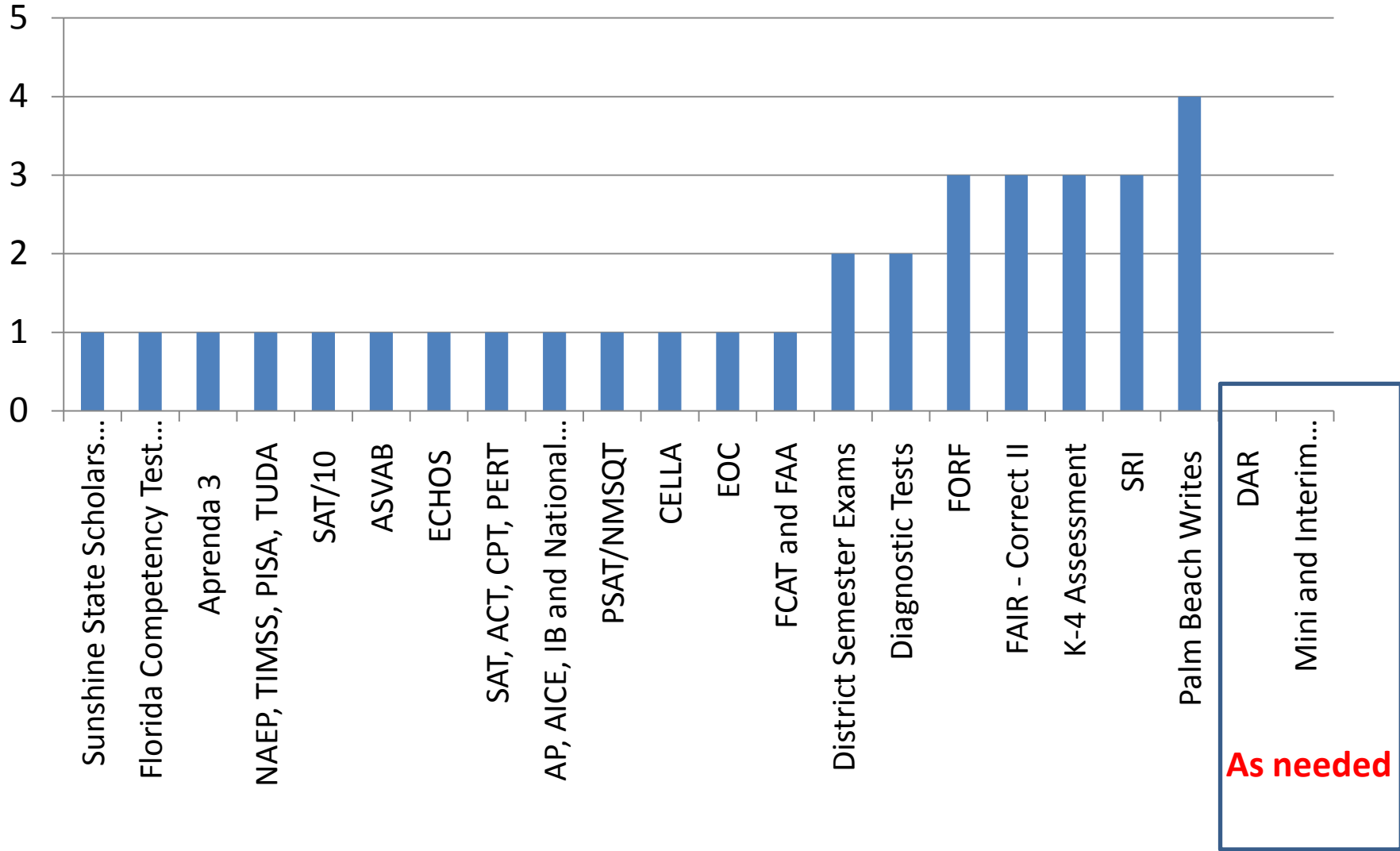
Total Hours in School
