SUBJECT: BIOLOGY 1 AND GEOMETRY END-OF-COURSE (EOC) ASSESSMENTS

The purpose of this communication is to provide you with the information about how the School District of Palm Beach County (SDPBC) will comply with the requirement that Biology 1 and Geometry End-of-Course (EOC) Assessments count for 30% of the final grade for students currently enrolled in Biology 1 and Geometry courses.

If your teachers ask you about how this requirement will impact how they will assign students' grades, please tell your teachers to continue to assign student grades as they have done in the past. The procedure for determining report card, semester, and transcript grades will not change. The SDPBC will calculate the final grade for students currently enrolled in Biology 1 and Geometry courses.
