

## EXHIBIT 3

East Boundary: moving clockwise, from the northeast corner

1. Start at the intersection of SCL Railroad (just west of I-95) and Summit Blvd
2. South on SCL railroad to Lake Worth Rd
3. East on Lake Worth Rd to Ave A South
4. South on Ave A to 6<sup>th</sup> Ave S
5. West on 6<sup>th</sup> Ave S to the SCL tracks
6. South on the SCL tracks to Lantana Rd
7. West on Lantana to Military Trail
8. South on Military to the L-28 Canal (one mile south of Boynton Beach Blvd)

South Boundary

1. West on the L-28 to the E-2 Canal (just east of the Turnpike)
2. North on the E-2 to Boynton Beach Blvd
3. West on Boynton Beach Blvd to State Rd 7
4. North on SR 7 to the canal .05 miles north of 95<sup>th</sup> St S
5. West on that canal to the L-40 Canal (on the east edge of the Loxahatchee Wildlife Refuge)

West Boundary

1. North, and then curving northwest, on the L-40 Canal to 160<sup>th</sup> Trail S (which lies on the west boundary of Wellington)
2. North .30 mile on 160<sup>th</sup> Trl S
3. East .03 mile to the canal just east of 160<sup>th</sup> Trl S
4. North 2.25 miles on the canal on the north boundary of Section 18 in Wellington

North Boundary

1. East on the canal just south of north line of Sections 18, 17 and 16, to the pond on the north edge of Section 16.
2. East on the canal leading from the pond to Big Blue Trace, crossing Big Blue and continuing northeast into and through the next lake to the C-14 Canal, continuing north on the C-14 to the West Palm Beach Canal (just south of Southern Blvd)
3. East on the WPB Canal to State Rd 7
4. South on SR 7 to Forest Hill Blvd
5. East on Forest Hill to the Turnpike
6. South on the Turnpike to Lake Worth Rd
7. East on Lake Worth to Military Trail
8. North on Military to Summit Blvd
9. East on Summit to SCL Railroad (just west of I-95), the point of beginning
