# LEED AND GREEN BUILDINGS

- Opened 2 soon-to-be-LEED-certified schools (Hope Centennial and CO Taylor/Kirklane)
- All-day workshops for entire staff of each school – “educational commissioning” (Steinkuehler)
- Similar workshop planned for PBGHS
- Interpretive signage, touchscreens (Steinkuehler)
- Energy evaluations of schools and entering data into EPA’s Energy Star program (Lacey)
- Program Management formed a “Green Project Team” (Lacey)
- Updates to District Design Criteria



# RESOURCE EFFICIENCY & CONSERVATION

- Energy & Water Conservation Policy passed in May 2009
- Resource Conservation Specialist Program (Kapp)
- EMS in portables
- Made energy data available to all schools via the web – ranks in terms of % savings; updated monthly
