



Evaluating Partnerships

Partnership evaluation should be ongoing. The results of the evaluation help determine strengths and weaknesses of the partnership. Evaluation results can be used to plan future activities and recognize successful partnerships.

Questions you might ask your partner:

1. Was your experience as a business partner positive and satisfying?
2. Was the principal of the school appreciative of your organization's efforts?
3. Was the partnership well defined?
4. Did the school provide valuable services to your firm?
5. Did the partnership achieve the education objectives established?

Questions you might ask school stakeholders:

1. Did students benefit from this program?
2. How do students in this program compare with others not in the program?
3. Does the program fit into the school curriculum?
4. Can this program survive without business funding and volunteers?
5. What short-term gains does this program offer?
6. Does this program respond to the objectives set in the beginning?
