The Five Star School Award is a symbol of achievement presented each year to schools that have shown exemplary community involvement. In order to qualify for the award, each school must document the achievement of 100% of the criteria in the categories:
1) Community/Business Partnerships, 2) Family Involvement, 3) Volunteers, 4) Student Community Service, and 5) School Advisory Councils.

This is the first award of its kind in the nation, and last year 78 schools in Palm Beach County achieved this recognition.
