### **Academic Performance (10 percent)**

### **Essay (50 percent)**

Explanations of what or who influenced you to study engineering, as well as what qualities or abilities about yourself you feel will make you well suited to become an engineer. Essay will be graded on content, neatness, grammar, spelling and creativity.

### **Awards/Honors (20 percent)**

Provide a list of all awards and honors you have received during high school with date of recognition and reason for merit. Provide no more than **one page** of awards or honors on separate sheet of paper.
