Mission Statement

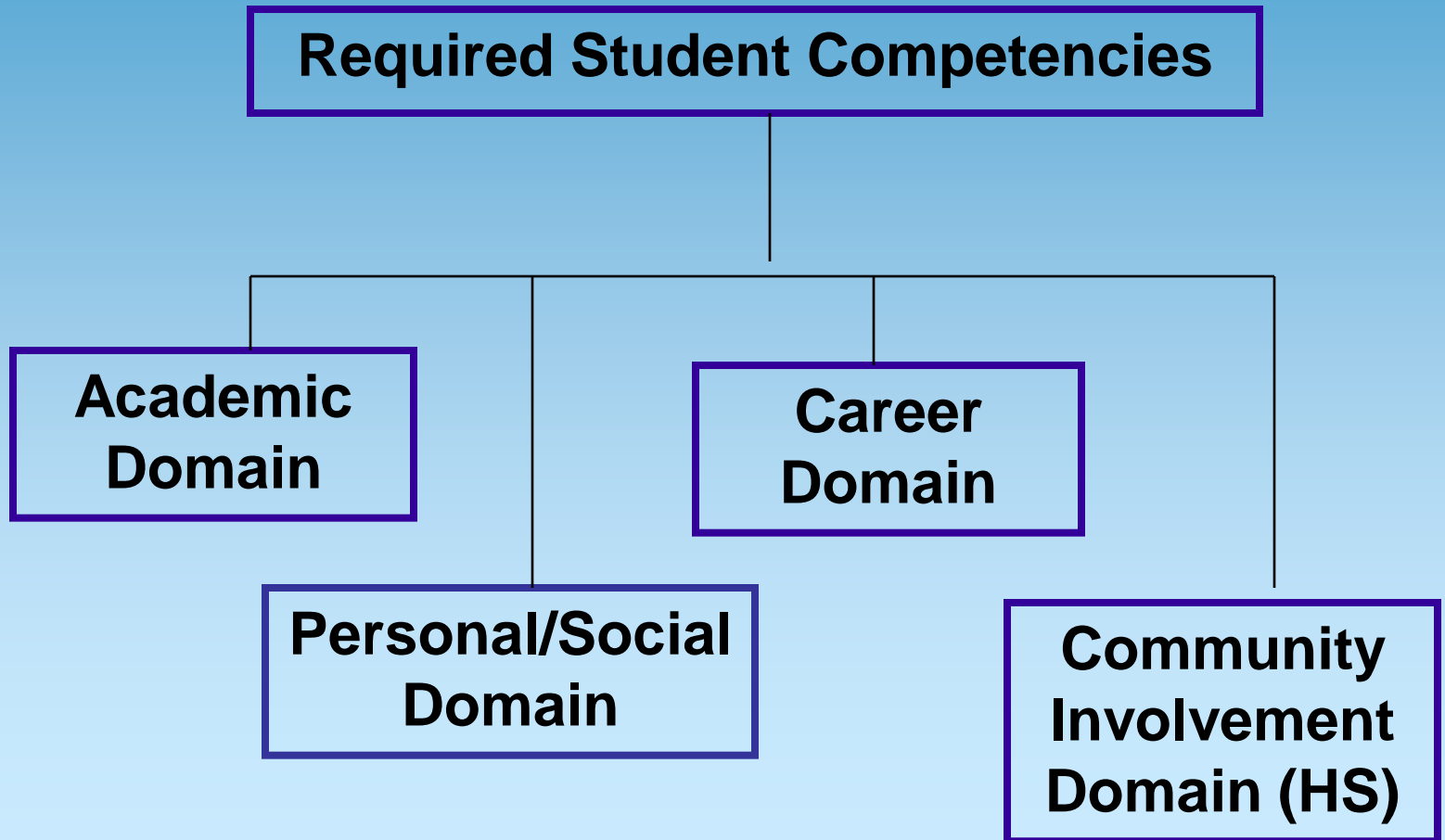
The mission of the Student Development Plan, which is based on National Standards, is to provide every student in Palm Beach County with the academic, personal/social and career competencies necessary for life-long success.

- Collects data to assess measurable student outcomes

Evidence of Success

MEASURE (Goal Setting Plan)

Conduct a needs assessment based on the analysis of data

Set goals for each domain with principal and staff based on School Improvement Plan

Develop and implement action plan

Submit completed MEASURES to the Department of Supplemental Educational Services

Evidence of Success

SPARC (Accountability Report Card)

Collect and analyze data relevant to the defined goals for each program domain

Compare end of year outcomes to set program goals

Use evaluation data to replicate success, identify barriers, and develop strategies to change practices and procedures for systematic change
