# Pat Oliphant Memorial Student Technology Service Scholarship Nomination

## SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The School District of Palm Beach County has created *Student Technology Service Scholarships* to recognize and reward outstanding high school seniors for service and support they have provided to their schools and/or communities in the area of technology.

1. Each high school has the opportunity to nominate one student for these non-renewable scholarship awards: First Place- \$3500, Second Place- \$2500, and Third Place- \$1500.
2. The judges will select finalists from the entries submitted. The finalists will be invited to interview with the judges in April.
3. The judges' criteria for selecting the finalists will be based solely on the information presented in the required documents (described below) with an emphasis on the nominees' technology service and support activities. Each submission should be limited to the information requested as no other information (newspaper articles, etc.) will be accepted.

## REQUIRED SCHOLARSHIP DOCUMENTS

Attach the following information to this nomination form:

1. A letter of recommendation from a Teacher, Guidance Counselor or Principal that has worked closely with the nominee. [Limit: One page, front only]
2. A description of the nominee's technology service and support to his/her school, the District, and/or the community (including accomplishments and awards). [Limit: One page, front and back]
3. A list of the nominee's other accomplishments including scholastics, extracurricular activities, sports participation, and community-related achievements and services. [Limit: One page, front and back]
