## MORNING/AFTER SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS CONTRACT

This contract has been designed to ensure the success of the participants, parents, and faculty in our programs. Its intention is to provide a safe environment, increase academic success and positive social interaction, and decrease the number of discipline referrals for each participant. Students who participate in these programs will be **REQUIRED** to abide by the following guidelines in order to ensure success at all levels.

1. All school rules apply including, but not limited to, the non-usage of cell phones, cameras and other personal electronic devices. These items will be confiscated if student is found using them.
2. Demonstrate the **R.O.A.R.** principles: **Respect** self, others and your school. **Own** your grades and decisions. **Always** be safe. **Reach** your goals.
3. Morning School students are to wait at the front school entrance until a staff member arrives to pick them up, and take them to the designated area. Breakfast will be provided.
4. After School students will report directly to the cafeteria where they will sign in and receive a snack.
5. Students who are absent from school may **NOT** attend the After School program on that day.
6. The only students eligible to ride the After-school Activity Buses are: students attending the After school program, athletes, students who attend the MSCR Program and school clubs. These students must have a completed Afterschool registration form on file.
7. Students who are suspended from their regular bus, serving afternoon detentions or staying after school to attend games are NOT permitted to ride the activity bus.
8. Parental pick-up must be coordinated prior to staying in the After School program. Any students attending After School must be picked up NO LATER THAN 5:30 P.M. This applies to **ALL** students.

### CONSEQUENCES FOR FAILING TO ADHERE TO THE ABOVE EXPECTATIONS WILL RESULT IN:

1. Verbal warning and a phone call to parents. Pick up may be required.
2. Referral and Suspension from the program.
3. Referral and Dismissal from the program.

**\*\* Certain infractions (fighting, threatening, stealing, and destruction of property) will result in immediate dismissal from the Program. \*\***
