- *School food service provides annual training for your employee/volunteers to ensure food safety*

FAQ's:

What would be the responsibilities of the Charter School?

Charter Schools will need to provide an area large enough to serve the students with a limited amount of equipment and an employee or volunteer who is ServSafe certified, to help distribute the food.

What is needed from the Health Department?

The Charter School must obtain a Limited Operating Permit from the Florida Health Department of Palm Beach County.

What are the responsibilities of the Food Service Department?

School food service will process:

- *All meal applications*
- *Conduct audits required by the state*
- *Provide meals that meet the minimum or exceed the USDA nutrition standards for the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs.*

What are the meal prices for 2015/16 school year?

Breakfast is free to all
Elementary school: \$2.05
Secondary school: \$2.30
Reduced lunch: \$.40
