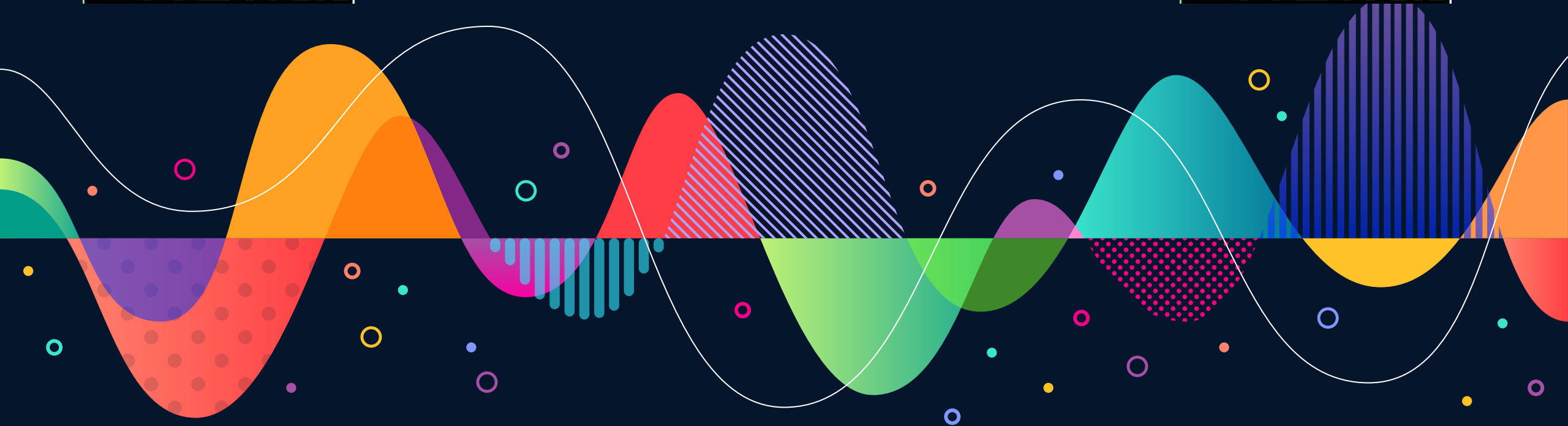

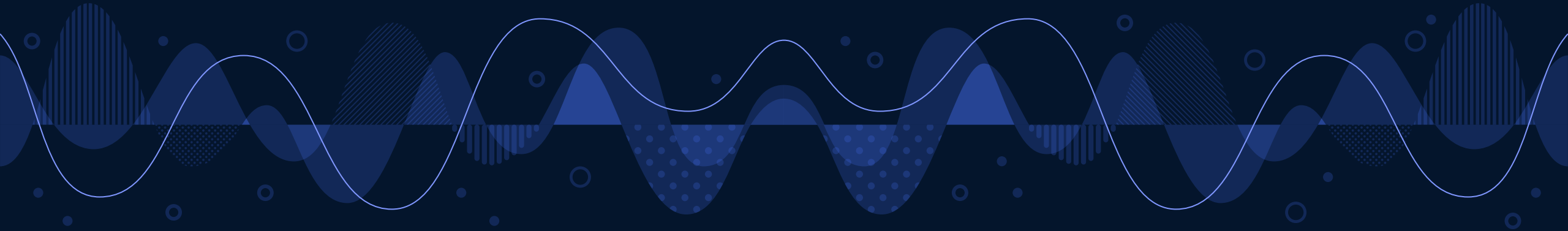

Adoption of Agenda & Approval of Minutes

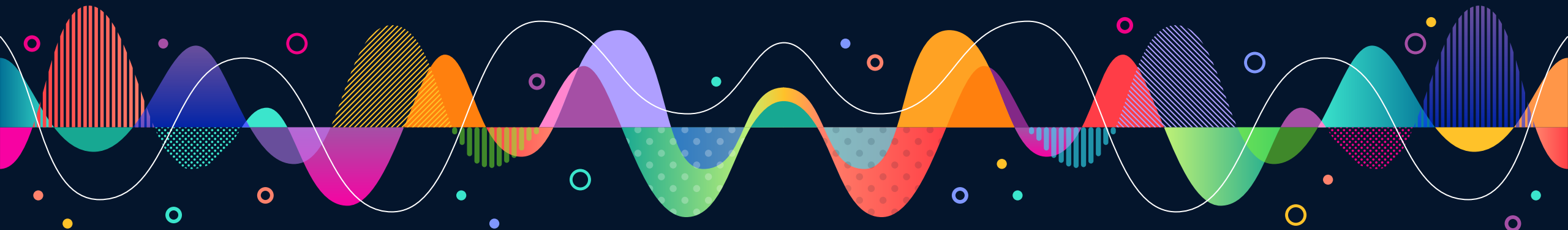


▶ Florida Sunshine Laws

▶ Ending SY23 SAC account balance \$2,523.41

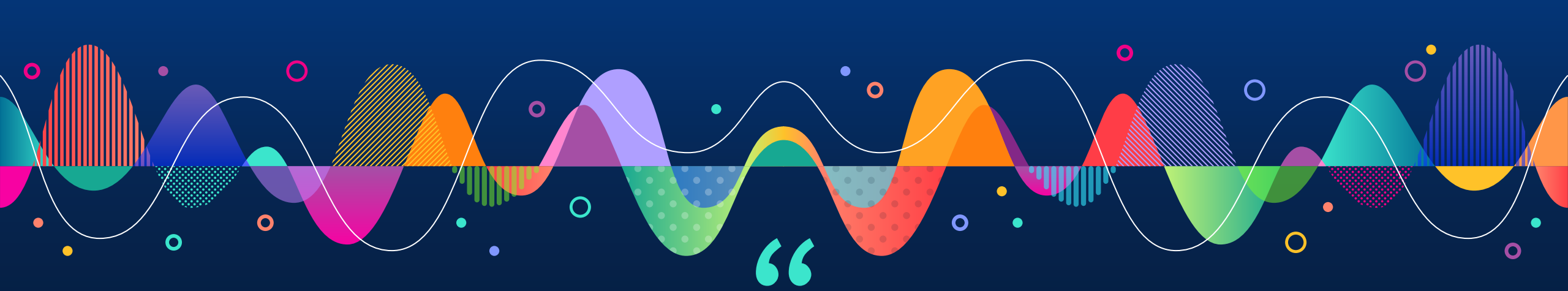




Election of New Voting Members SAC Members

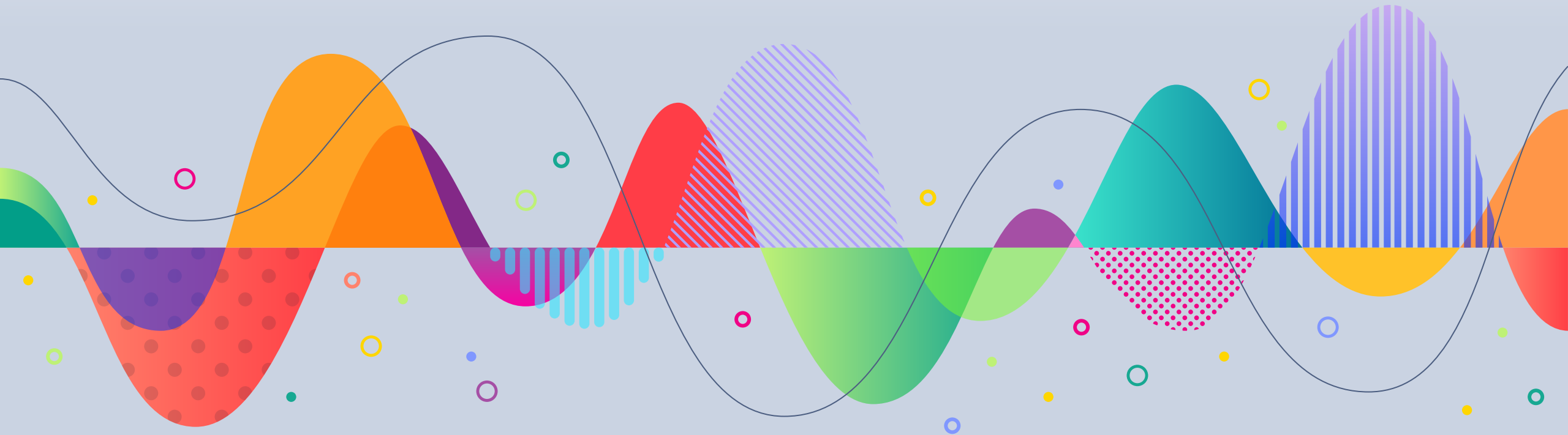

- **Our Data reflects the following strengths:**
 - **ELA - 6th Grade 52% PM1 to 55% PM3 - 3 pt Increase**
 - **Math - Achieved our Goal of 50% by 3 pts (Scrubbed)**

GROWING INTO GREATNESS



ELA

By the end of SY 24, 50% (+4) of our students will meet proficiency or higher. 65% of our students will make learning gains



Math

By the end of SY 24, 55% (+2) of our students will meet proficiency or higher. 65% of our students will make learning gains



Science

Students in 5th grade Science and 8th Grade Science will meet 55% (+15) proficiency



Civics

By the end of SY24, our students in 7th Grade Civics will meet proficiency of 80%, which is +6 point increase



Acceleration

By the end of SY24, students in accelerated courses will meet 95% proficiency

SY24 SCHOOL GRADE "A"

Election of Officers

- ▶ **Chairperson**- The chairperson shall preside at all meetings of the council and shall be a de facto member of all committees.
- ▶ **Vice-Chairperson**- The vice-chairperson shall act as an aide to chairperson and preside in the absence of the chairperson. In case of a vacancy in the office of the chairperson, the vice-chairperson shall become the chairperson for the remainder of the unexpired term
- ▶ **Secretary**- The secretary shall keep minutes of the meetings and shall be responsible for such correspondence is delegated to him/her by there chairperson. The secretary shall also document activities, decisions, and attendance of the Council and its committees for accountability.
- ▶ **Historian**- The historian shall document the past, present, and future progress of the SAC and its committees. The historian shall maintain the minutes of previous years, any anecdotal records, and the SAC archives.
