Dear Students and Families,

As you may know, there is a **solid link** between the amount of independent reading children do and their success in school. Reading helps build fluency, background knowledge, and vocabulary. Summer break often means a break from reading, which can seriously hamper achievement in the classroom. Research shows that kids who never crack open a book during the summer often fall behind in reading – the notorious "summer slide" – while kids who do read, maintain or improve their learning skills.

ALL STUDENTS must:

- Read ONE book from the <u>Grades 6-8 2024-2025 Sunshine State Young Readers Award</u> <u>Book</u> list.
- 2. Complete **EITHER** a <u>Book Talk on Flip Grid</u> (ONLY teachers can view) **OR** <u>Make a One-Pager</u> on cardstock/poster board.
- 3. Complete the 2024-2025 **Summer Reading Acknowledgement Form** for the **grade you'll be in** during the <u>upcoming</u> school year: <u>6th grade</u>, <u>7th grade</u>, <u>8th grade</u>
