The dedication to teaching and learning at Dreyfoos has been recognized again! The US News and World Report released the 2023 rankings today for all high schools in our nation. Dreyfoos is now ranked #90 in the entire country! Last year, we ranked #111 and this is an enormous jump breaking the top 100! There are approximately 18,000 high schools in the nation and this places us in the top half of 1% of all high schools in the United States, let alone ranking #24 for all magnet high schools (previously #28)!

I am incredibly proud of all of the hard work from our students and the dedication of our amazing teachers, staff, counselors, and assistant principals leading to Alexander W. Dreyfoos School of the Arts ranking in the top 100 high schools in the nation. Students truly receive a world-class arts and academic education at Dreyfoos.

I would like to take a moment to recognize our Counseling Department. Our phenomenal counselors organize College Bootcamps on Saturdays and after school to assist students with college applications, essays, Common App, resume building, and so much more! This is an extraordinary undertaking and our counselors make sure the seniors have all the tools they need to achieve their dreams. Jazz

Our DSOA jazz students had quite a busy summer learning from renowned Jazz Educators and Grammy-winning Jazz Performers. Many of our students spent time at the Jazz at Lincoln Center Summer Jazz Academy in NYC, Brevard Jazz Institute in North Carolina, New York University's Jazz Improv and Composers Workshop, The Frost School of Music Advance Jazz Camp in Miami, Florida State University Jazz Camp, Interlochen Jazz Performance and Improvisation Camp in Michigan, and the University of North Florida Jazz Camp. We are proud of our student's initiative to focus on further developing their skills over the summer.

DOWNBEAT magazine is the world's largest monthly publication that specializes in all styles of music that would fall under the umbrella of the "Jazz Genre" and this worldwide monthly publication has been published since 1934. Beginning in 1977, they have had the annual DOWNBEAT Student Music Awards. Graduate /undergraduate jazz universities and high schools have consistently applied and submitted recordings to win one of their coveted awards in over 10 categories. This past June, we received notification that our Jazz Ensemble 1 was the co-winner in the Large Jazz Ensemble Category, Performing Arts High School Division. The jazz programs of Douglas Anderson School of the Arts (FL), Las Vegas Academy of the Arts (NV), and the Los Angeles County High School of the Arts were ranked 2nd-4th place respectively. Full results were released in the June issue of Downbeat Magazine. Congratulations to our jazz students!

We are excited to share that our Jazz Ensemble 1 students were selected from a HUGE pool of recorded submissions as a High School Jazz Program of Excellence to perform at the 2024 Jazz Education Network International Conference in New Orleans, LA (the birthplace of Jazz). JEN's annual conference is a gathering of jazz educators, students, professional musicians, researchers, and music industry professionals from across the globe. The conference features performances, workshops, clinics, and research presentations from experts in the field of jazz performance and jazz education. NOLA here we come!

Students in the scene shop are learning the fundamentals of hand drafting, planning designs for Puffs and studying our spring mainstage show, Twelfth Night.

Acting classes are taking a deep dive into scene study with their first project, A\B scenes, while our upper-level students are preparing their college prescreen monologues. Our goal is to get every senior to apply for the Young Arts Scholarship this year! Our improv students are learning to say 'Yes, And!' leading to making students feel comfortable making choices and taking risks.

Students in Theatre History are exploring the early development of theatre and "The Ritualist Theory" by exploring the theatrical nature of rituals through hands-on projects! In acting and devised theatre, students are focusing on ensemble building and collaboration, while making extraordinary shapes together as an ensemble.

Musical theatre students are singing up a storm with individual solo presentations and class songs from Broadway musicals such as Sister Act, Les Miserables, Carrie, Something Rotten, and Oklahoma! Our dance students are mastering correct dance terminology, alignment, and training for increased endurance.

While classes are busy and jam-packed, we have been equally busy with so many wonderful opportunities outside of the school day! On August 26th, the International Thespian Society Annual Picnic was held in John Prince Park with one of the highest turnouts we've ever had! Burgers, games, and a lot of shaving cream were par for the course! Our Improv Comedy Troupe, Hairy Details, has been fully cast and working toward their first show on September 15th, during lunch. 


