

### Student and Family Handbook

The purpose of the Student and Family Handbook is to communicate the expectations, policies, and procedures for the school year for all of the students and their families in Palm Beach County Schools. This is the handbook used to guide every school in Palm Beach County and is a valuable resource.

The <u>FY24 Student and Family Handbook</u> is complete and available on the District Website in English, Spanish, Portuguese, and Haitian Creole.

Any student who missed the original photo will receive a pass to come down and be photographed on Monday, Oct. 23.

RETAKES: If you purchased a picture package that you are unhappy with due to a photographer error, the retake is free of charge. A photographer error would include pictures that are too dark, washed out, or incorrectly cropped.

If you are unhappy due to other issues that are not photographer error, a \$15 fee will be charged. These may include, but are not limited to, issues such as a bad hair day, or a student being unhappy with a smile. There is a \$5 fee for retaking for the yearbook or ID only.

No form is needed for the retake, but students must return the original photo prints to the photographer at the time of the retake. Include a printed copy of the Retake Fee Receipt.

We even had a school-wide celebration during lunch! The students had a blast at our fiesta!





The 2023 AP School Honor Roll also recognizes Alexander W Dreyfoos School Of The Arts as providing all students the chance to participate in AP, including students of underrepresented populations.

"Congratulations to A.W. Dreyfoos School of the Arts which was named to the 2023 AP School Honor Roll! The AP School Honor Roll recognizes schools who AP program are delivering results and broadening access for students.

Schools can earn the Honor Roll recognition annually based on their ability to increase their school's college-going culture, to provide opportunities for students to earn college credit, and maximizing college readiness. The AP School Honor Roll offers four levels of distinction: Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum.

College Board's Advanced Placement® Program (AP®) enables students to pursue college-level studies—with the opportunity to earn college credit, advanced placement, or both—while still in high school. Through AP courses in 38 subjects, each culminating in a challenging exam, students learn to think critically, construct solid arguments, and see many sides of an issue—skills that prepare them for college and beyond. Taking AP courses demonstrates to college admissions officers that students have sought the most challenging curriculum available to them, and research indicates that students who score a 3 or higher on an AP Exam typically experience greater academic success in college and are more likely to earn a college degree than non-AP students."




Membership starts with an annual donation as small as \$50. There are many levels of Dreyfoos membership, each with special benefits to show our gratitude for your support.




