Pearls of Ruth Foundation, Inc. Legacy Scholarship

Criteria: Applicants must be a graduating female senior attending a Title I high school in Hendry or Palm Beach County whose mother is deceased, and she plans to enroll in a 2 or 4 year college, university, or technical school (verification of acceptance is required to receive the scholarship).

Scholarships are based on: Financial need, community service, which may include mentoring or volunteering, and academic performance requiring a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Finalists will be invited to a personal interview with the foundation's selection committee members.

Awards: One time scholarship of \$500 for tuition, books, and fees.

Submission: Completed applications must include an official transcript, two letters of recommendation from a school administrator, counselor, teacher or community leader and your college essay. The essay must be no more than 500 words, on how you would help the community and others. It must be typed, double-spaced, and 12 pt Times New Roman. **Application must be signed and submitted with essay as a packet.**

Official Transcript: An official transcript must be postmarked before April 15th and mailed to: Leola Horton, Scholarship Chair of Pearls of Ruth Foundation, Inc. P. O. Box 4142 West Palm Beach, FL 33402.

Presentation: Scholarships will be presented at the annual legacy luncheon in May. Winners will be announced via email and phone call no later than April 15th. All students awarded a scholarship are expected to be present for this event and may invite a guest, compliments of Pearls of Ruth Foundation, Inc.
