Annual Title I Meeting

Parent and Family Engagement Activities

Based on the family survey input, we will provide the following trainings for families that will build capacity to support learning at home to improve student academic achievement:

- Pathway to Graduation for all parents and students. Participants will be trained on how to navigate through their student's SIS portal and review current grades, test scores, and requirements needed to graduate. This training will be held on Tuesday, October 17, 2023.
- Literacy Night: Parents will become familiar with the Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T) in English Language Arts. Parents will gain resources on assisting their children with literacy strategies and will navigate through practice test sites, and review writing samples. This training will be held on Tuesday, January 23, 2024.
