## Reasons to Participate in "I CAN"

In these difficult economic times, American families need quality afterschool programs more than ever. In communities today, 15.1 million children take care of themselves after the school day ends. The hours between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. are the peak hours for juvenile crime and experimentation with drugs, alcohol, cigarettes and sex. The afterschool hours can be a time for trouble or a time for kids to learn new skills, develop relationships with caring adults and prepare for the future. In a country where only one third of young people graduate high school prepared for college, work and citizenship, we can't afford to waste the after school hours.



### General Information

All students are welcome to participate in the Aftercare Program.

Daily participation is NOT required.

A snack and a drink are provided each day.

### Registration

There is no cost to participate in the Aftercare Program at this time. Students must have a registration form completed, signed, and on file before participating.

### Transportation

An activity bus is available for students who are *regular* bus riders, and live in the schools SAC zone. The bus departs campus at 5:40 p.m. Regular afternoon bus stops are NOT used so please refer to the after school bus schedule to locate a convenient stop. Parent pick-up is *required* by 5:40 p.m. Walkers and bike riders are also dismissed at this time.

## Who will Supervise my child?

I CAN teachers are faculty members who have volunteered to supervise students during our afterschool program

### Days of Operation

Monday—Thursday 4:10—5:40 P.M.

Students report to the cafeteria right after school. The program does not meet on Fridays or school holidays.
