Mrs. Capute – Second Grade - Holocaust age appropriate –tolerance. Veterans. Reading Writing assessments on Friday. Math working on double addition/subtraction. Using strategies, they like most to do the math.

Dr. Griffin – PBIS model school Award– positive behavior matrix – systems to adhere to student expectations. Year long impact and assessments for PBS. Messaging has to be clear. New we have Peli Bills – positive reinforcement with the "Bait Shop"

MTSS - Award - school based team and tiered support. We won this - growth in the lowest 25

percent recognizing school based teams. (awarded by state) - what does this mean? Interventions are working. MTSS is Multi Tiered System of Support

Coach Corrar - #2 in district in 2023 for American Heart Challenge.

Mrs. Merritt – Go Teach Grant - first one in Mrs. Montez' tenure! Grant awarded from the education foundation of Palm Beach \$3,000 for the lunch bunch (a special daily lunch for kids - her IEP students work on social awareness, acceptance, and building friendships through play) Data capture, online element, and collaboration with teachers to show improvements with both needs students and mainstream students. "Peer Pals". Peer Pal selection criteria built with curriculum creator. Mrs. Merritt works with teachers to identify students who demonstrate tolerance etc.

Next book for our literacy initiative Tammy/Crystal using the last of Esser funds getting books into families hands. Three books per year – the next one coming home after thanksgiving before winter break. A bad case of the stripes – about being yourself. Goes home to every single family with comprehension questions. Fostering love of reading and connection at home.
