





The purpose of this *Back to School Edition! Newspaper* is to remind you of some of the important policies we have at Northmore.



How Does Your Child Go Home?

It is very important that parents let the teachers and front office know how their child goes home. Any changes to dismissal must be made in writing and sent to the front office.

Please make sure your child keeps his/her transportation wristband on his/her backpack or wrist at all times. These wristbands will tell all the adults how your child goes home.

Walking Students to Class

All parents are allowed to walk their child to class on Thursday, August 10 and Friday, August 11.

Monday, August 14 is Independence Day!

This means that all students will walk to their correct locations without their parents.

No need to worry! We will have staff all around the campus helping students locate their classrooms.

Student Attendance Policies

Student Arrival and Free Breakfast

7:40 a.m. - 8:10 a.m.

Students will receive free breakfast from the cafeteria. After 8:10 a.m. students are considered late and marked tardy.



Instructional Hours

8:10 a.m. - 2:05 p.m.

Instruction begins promptly at 8:10 a.m. and stops at 2:05 p.m. It is extremely important that students remain in school unless they are sick so that they can learn everything they need to for the day.

Student Tardies Anytime After 8:10 a.m.

Parents will be required to park in one of the open parking spots. Parents must then walk their late child into the front office and sign his/her child in. Only 2 parents are allowed in the front office at a time.



Early Release

No Early Release After 1:40 p.m.

Any adult who comes onto campus to pick up a student must be on the student's approved pick-up list and have their government issued Photo ID. Students will not be released if these two criteria are not met.

Students will not be released after 1:40 p.m. due to dismissal preparation. Only a member of administration can make this change in the event of an emergency.

Student Absences

More than 5 Absences is considered excessive.

All students need to be in school in order to learn. We understand that students may stay home because they are sick or have a Doctor's appointment. However, after 5 unexcused absences, the parent will be contacted by the school and develop a student Attendance Plan. The Principal or Assistant Principal will be part of this process.

Student Dismissal | 2:10 p.m. - 2:35 p.m.

Student Dismissal begins at 2:10 p.m. and lasts until 2:35 p.m. Parents who are late in picking up their students will be charged a late pick-up fee.

Car Riders will be dismissed from the back of the school off of Windsor Avenue. The gate will be opened at 1:45 p.m. and no earlier. All cars are to follow the directions given by the staff working at the gate.

Dependent Walkers are Kindergarten and 1st Grade students who will be picked up at the North Gate off of North Terrace Drive by the portables. Parents must be able to show identification.

Independent Walkers are 2nd - 5th Grade students who will be dismissed through the South Gate off of North Terrace Drive.

Please Note

Parents of walkers who park their cars across the street from the school are breaking the law. Parents may be given a ticket by the City of West Palm Beach Police or School Police. This creates an unsafe environment for our students.
