Assistant Principal Report: M. Schmitz

- Diagnostic data review
 - o 3-5 Diagnostics:
 - Diagnostics showed declines in predicted scores due to COVID slide
 - Biggest decline was in math, but the diagnostic covers untaught standards.
 - ELA scores on FSA will include writing which the diagnostic does not; writing scores generally help students scores improve
 - Science increased from 40% last year to 68% proficiency this year
 - Data chats with students and teachers will begin soon
 - K-2 iReady Diagnostics:
 - Given 3 times a year
 - Fundations is currently fully implemented in gen ed classrooms.
 - Increases in percentage of students on or above grade level in all grades
 - 3-5 iReady diagnostic data will be shared at next meeting
