





Viewing your Classes




Once the student has logged into the portal and selected the google classroom tile, all of the classes for the student will appear on the dashboard.




Submitting an Assignment


There could be several ways for students to submit work depending upon how the assignment was given or the type of assignment. Below is an example of a google doc that was assigned to the student. The student completed the bullet list and then selected "Turn In"



After selecting "Turn in" located in the upper right hand corner of Image A, the student was prompted with a message that asked are you sure you want to turn in your work?" (Image B) The student must select "Turn in" again to confirm. Then the student will see a confirmation message. A sample of this message is displayed in Image C. Notice the image shows that the assignment has been Turned In. It also show the student that they can un-submit if they feel the submission was not complete.


Submitting from Kami






Kami is a program that some teachers are using to allow their students to write over the top of a worksheet.

Students who may be utilizing this program have a slightly different view when turning in work. Notice in Image A there is an option to save and turn in located in the upper right hand corner of the screen. Upon Selecting "Turn In", another box will pop up (displayed in image B) with the file name and the option to confirm that the student wants to "turn in" the assessment. The work is then sent over to google classroom and the student will receive the same messages as if submitting an assignment in google drive.





Guardian Summaries



Parents can request the teacher to enable Guardian Summaries. This enables parents to provide an email address to which they would like to receive regular reports. Parents can choose to receive reports monthly, weekly, or even daily. In the Guardian Summary, parents will get a list of the missing work and when the assignment was due as well as a list of items that are coming due soon. This is a great way for parents to keep up with their student's work.
