Policy 8.124 Student Guidelines: Taking Devices Home



- Your device belongs to the district. Do not loan, sell, or trade the device. Do not attempt to repair equipment on your own or take it to an outside vendor for any type of repairs or maintenance.
- Keep your password private. Never share your password.
- Always know where your device is. Do not leave your backpack or device at home or inside of your vehicle unattended.
- Use the device for school assignments, school work, and school-related activities only.
- Refrain from accessing websites not related to classroom assignments.
 You are responsible for the ethical and educational use of technology resources.
- Student work should be stored on Google Drive. No local storage or USB device is needed.
- When your device is not in use, logoff or lock your screen.
- Charge your device every night.
- When in school, transport your district device in your backpack at all times.
- Do not throw your backpack when the device is inside.
- It is recommended to use the device only at your school and at home. When required, please use caution when connecting to other networks.
- Bring the device to school every day, fully charged.
- If your device is lost, stolen, or damaged, inform your parents and teachers immediately.
