| <ul> <li>Cell phones &amp; Head phones should not be seen, heard, or used during instructional time unless the teacher authorizes it for educational purposes</li> <li>If your phone becomes a disruption during class time, the device will be confiscated and a disciplinary consequence will be given</li> <li>Taking photos or videos in classrooms is not permitted</li> <li>Portable speakers are not permitted on campus at any time.</li> </ul> Olympic Heights High School is not responsible for lost or stolen items  | <ul> <li>Students are tardy if they are standing outside of the classroom door when the bell stops ringing</li> <li>Tardies 1-4 result in a pass to class</li> <li>Tardies 5-8 will result in a Thursday Afternoon detention</li> <li>9 or more will be loss of privileges for the remainder of the quarter, parking on campus, field trips, pep rallies and attending sporting events (athletes included)</li> <li>Tardies 15 + will be considered insubordination and will result in a day of in-school suspension and loss of extracurricular privileges</li> <li>More than 50 minutes lates will result in an absence</li> </ul>  |
| Locker rooms and unattended backpacks are easy targets for potential thefts. Students are urged to lock up their cell phones/headphones during PE or extracurricular activities.   | Attendance  □ Lack of consistent attendance negatively impacts the learning process □ Make-up work is assigned to cover what was missed but will never have the same impact as the original lesson  |
| Sign In/Out  | <u>Dress Code</u>   |
| Students that arrive after the start of school must sign in at the Front Office in order to receive a tardy pass to class  Doctors notes and or other documentation needs to be presented in order to have the tardy excused  Sign-Out  Early dismissal notes must be presented to the Front Office before school begins  Notes must contain the student's name, student number, date, time, reason for dismissal, and method of departure. The parent will be contacted to verify the letter  Parents/guardians must meet their child in the Main Office to be signed out prior to release  Students cannot be signed out of school after 2:15 p.m.  We do not accept restaurant deliveries for student lunches or any other time of day. | <ul> <li>Absolutely no halter tops, T-tops, tube tops, bandanas, spaghetti string tops, tank tops and sleeveless jerseys.</li> <li>All blouses, shirts, and tops must be high enough to eliminate exposure of cleavage and long enough to prevent exposure of midriff, back, or sides.</li> <li>Shorts, skirts, and dresses must reach the mid-thigh or fingertip length.</li> <li>Clothing should not be sheer or see-through to where undergarment is exposed.</li> <li>No head covering of any kind (exceptions of medical or religious reasons.) That includes baseball caps, hats, hoods, bandanas, scarves, wave caps or headbands. These articles will be confiscated.</li> <li>Bedroom slippers or pajamas should not be worn.</li> <li>Clothing, jewelry, buttons, etc. with words, phrases, symbols, pictures or insignia which are disruptive, obscene, profane, racist, suggestive, or related to drug or alcohol use are not permitted. Clothing which is offensive is not allowed.</li> <li>Appropriate clothing can be worn on approved SGA "dress up" days.</li> <li>Rips in jeans should not be inappropriate and excessive</li> </ul> |
