Teachers will choose 5 higher order question stems and post them where they will see them to encourage higher order questioning.
- 2. To increase **Math** and meet our goal, our school will concentrate on utilizing Dreambox, Spiral Reviews, FSQs and USAs, morning/afterschool tutoring.

- providing a safe, supportive, and effective learning environment to increase student achievement
- providing a high-quality curriculum and instruction that enables children to meet the State's academic achievement standards
- keeping a positive, two-way communication with parents/families on an on-going basis, and maintaining meaningful communication between school-home in a language they understand
- providing parents/families with frequent reports on their child's progress (minimum of 3) and partner with them to improve student achievement to meet the State's grade level standards
- providing families with specific strategies and resources to support their child's learning at home
- providing on-going opportunities for parents/families to share and be partners in the decision-making process related to the education of their children to increase their academic success

- taking an active role in their child's learning by attending parent/family training events to learn strategies to help increase their child's academic success to meet the State's grade level standards or volunteer
