SENIORS - FLORIDA BRIGHT FUTURES SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION IS NOW OPEN:

- FL Bright Futures is a merit-based scholarship available to Florida students to use at Florida colleges/universities.

- Seniors must submit a Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA) in order to receive the Bright Futures Scholarship.
- Important info about College Entrance Exams (ACT/SAT/CLT) for Bright Futures Scholarship:
 - Students will be evaluated based on official test scores from the FLDOE repository. To ensure that your scores are sent to the repository & OSFA obtains test scores for Bright Futures, please do the following:
 - 1. Ensure demographics on your test registration and high school transcript match; and
 - 2. Request your official single-sitting test scores be sent to one of Florida's public colleges or state universities when registering for the ACT®, CLT®, or SAT®. Note: Students can request ACT test scores be sent directly to Bright Futures using CEEB code 0095 while on ACT's website.



HOW TO SUBMIT ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS:

 - 4) PBSD Form 1589HS Student Medical Consent for Athletics
 - 5) PBSD Form 2608 Interscholastic Athletics Accident Insurance (include receipt of payment)
 - 6) 3 NFHS Course Certificates: 1. Concussion for Students, 2. Heat Illness, 3. Sudden Cardiac Arrest
