## HOW TO SUBMIT ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS:

- Students interested in playing high school sports must register and submit the required state, district, & school eligibility documents into the online system <u>www.Aktivate.com</u>. Click here for <u>Aktivate.com Instructions</u>
- Student-athletes will need to electronically complete or digitally upload the following documents on Aktivate:
  - 1) FHSAA EL2 Participation Physical
  - 2) FHSAA EL3 Consent and Release
  - 3) PBSD Form 1588HS Athletic Eligibility for High School Students
  - 4) <u>PBSD Form 1589HS</u> Student Medical Consent for Athletics
  - 5) <u>PBSD Form 2608</u> Interscholastic Athletics Accident Insurance (include receipt of payment)
  - 6) 3 NFHS Course Certificates: 1. <u>Concussion for Students</u>, 2. <u>Heat Illness</u>, 3. <u>Sudden Cardiac Arrest</u>
  - 7) Birth Certificate (for proof of age purposes only)
- After you have completed the Aktivate.com registration and uploaded the required documents, check your Aktivate.com account for a "Cleared" status. If "Not Cleared", correct/submit any missing/incomplete documents.
