Mesh or Clear Backpacks

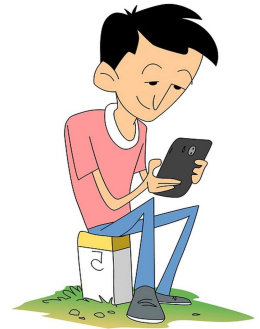


- Students must use a clear or mesh backpack.

NEW Classroom Supplies & Backpack Policy

- Teaching in the smartphone era has become incredibly challenging for educators.

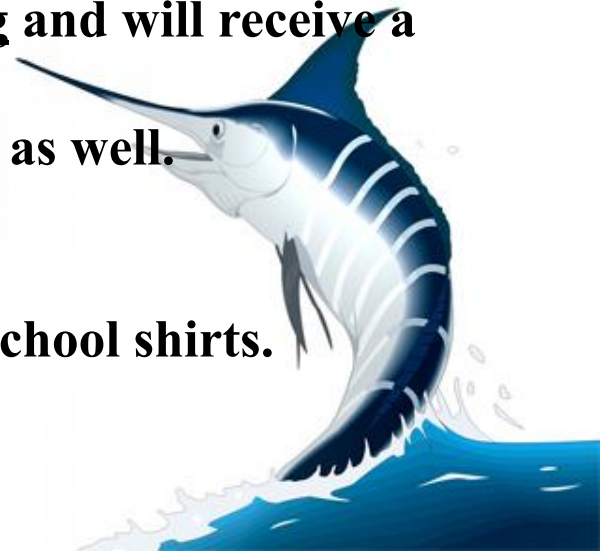

- Dress code has been updated and now permits hoodies without zippers (no hoods on heads), joggers, and sweatpants.

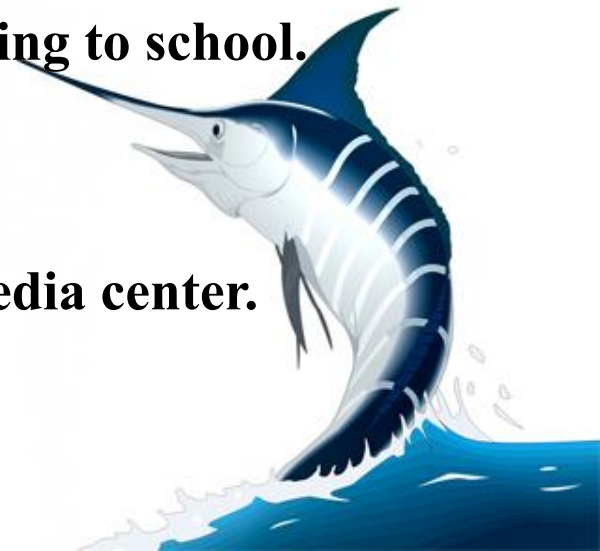

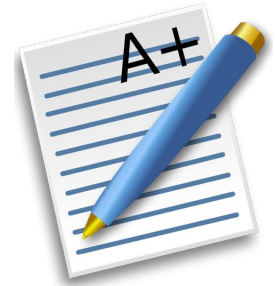

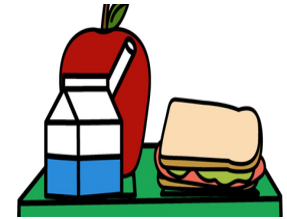

Cafeteria Service

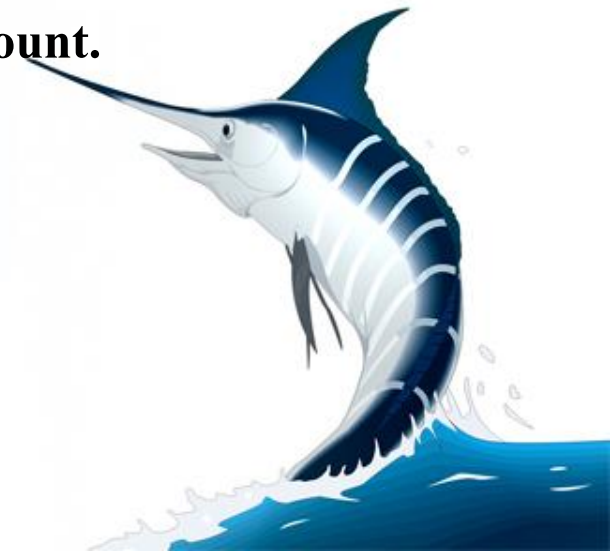
- **Breakfast-** 7:30–7:50 a.m.

- Specific information will be provided by the classroom teacher at the opening of school.

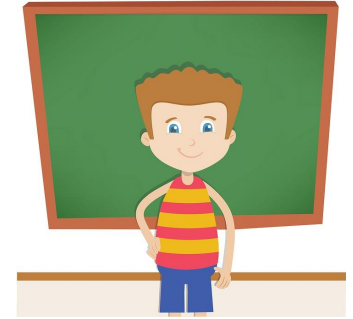


CHROMEBOOKS

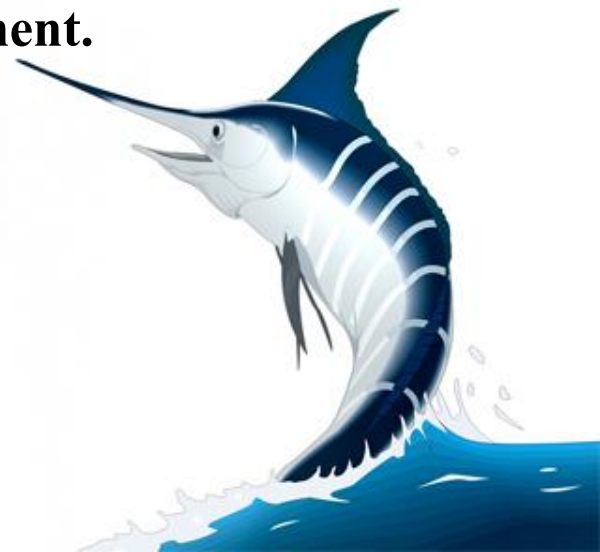
