Students <u>MUST</u> wear their ID Badges every day per school district policy. Students may wear their own break-a-way school appropriate lanyard with their ID Badge. Students may not hang any items on their lanyards other than the ID badge (no toys, pins, etc.).

OVER THE COUNTER HEADACHE MEDICINE Florida Statute F.S. 1002.20(3)(p) allows a student to possess and self-administer headache medication to relieve headaches while on school property or at a school-sponsored event or activity without a physician's note or prescription. The medication must be regulated by the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for overthe-counter use to treat headaches. Administration of over-thecounter headache medication regulated by the FDA shall be in accordance with Policy 5.321 Administration of Student Medication/Treatment. The student is solely responsible for safely administering and transporting the over-the-counter headache medication to and from school each day. The medication must be in an original container and labeled with the student's name by the custodial parent/guardian. Parents/guardians requesting the student to self-administer over-the-counter headache medication must submit a written request to the school on Form PBSD 2683. Please contact the front office if you need a copy of this form.

DRESS CODE POLICY - IMPORTANT

We have a mandatory dress code at Sunset Palms. ALL students are expected to be in dress code daily. No stripes, patterns, designs. Please see the details below.

The policy sets guidelines for students to create an atmosphere that fosters learning without fashion distractions and safety hazards. Students who DO NOT adhere to the dress code policy will receive an area of concern on the "Follows rules/routines/directions" section on the report card. Please contact the front office if you need assistance with obtaining dress code items. Shirts with logos may be purchased through our PTA. Other school dress code items may be purchased at any retail store.

Tops – Solid collared shirts (Any color, short sleeve or long sleeve, with or without the Sunset Palms logo). The Sunset Palms logo is preferred. **No stripes, patterns or designs**.

Sweatshirts- Solid color (free from decorations and writing) sweatshirts may be worn over the collared shirts in the classroom. Bottoms –Pants, capris, shorts, skirts, leggings and skorts (solid khaki, navy, black). No stripes, patterns or designs.

Uniform Jumpers – Plain solid collared shirt underneath. Uniform Polo Dresses – Solid colors

STEM FAIR PROJECTS

Your child will have the opportunity to compete in our Virtual Elementary Math, Science and STEM (EMSS) Fair this year! The annual EMSS Fair is an adventure in learning, and the development of a project is an engaging activity for expanding your child's understanding of math and science applications, and building higher order critical thinking skills. All students in grades K-5 may participate and submit a project for our school's virtual showcase. Students in grades 3-5 only may submit a theme project, or a team project (2-4 students per team: same grade level). First place winners in each category and grade level will advance to the district's Virtual Showcase, and all projects will be celebrated school-wide on March 1st, 2024. Students will submit projects via Google Doc, which will be sent to all students who participate. FINAL PROJECTS ARE DUE BY FRIDAY, JANUARY 12th, 2024. Students have the option of completing math, science or STEM-based projects. Students can explore ideas such as aviation, green, physical science, or energy to make their projects eligible for the THEME-based category. A complete list of all the project types and categories, along with the competition rules, regulations and safety considerations are detailed in the Student Guide, which will be sent home via email by your child's classroom teacher. All projects must be a digital presentation using one of the following

formats: Google Slides (12 slides maximum), Adobe Express Video (5 minutes maximum), Screencastify or another form of an mp4 video (5 minutes maximum), PDF created from Word, Google Docs, or Adobe Express

If your child is interested in participating in the EMSS Virtual Fair this school year, please join the **Google Classroom** using the code **t7ew2ga**. All fair related information including deadlines, project assistance, samples of projects, and required forms (including informed consent/assent and human/animal subject forms) will be available in the Google Classroom. All project-specific questions that students may have can be posted in the Google classroom.
