# HERE COMES THE BUS (HCTB)

Here Comes the Bus (HCTB) is an easy-to-use website and application that enables parents to see the location of their child's school bus on a smartphone, tablet, or personal computer. Please review the HCTB informational video to provide a quick product overview.

HCTB is a parent-facing application, which means that parents themselves must register to use the product. Here is a link introducing HCTB and information regarding what you will need to register your student(s).

Registration for HCTB requires some key steps, as outlined below. Before attempting to sign up for HCTB, bus riders must be registered to ride the bus. Parents will need to complete Register Your Ride. Register Your Ride requires two pieces of student information The username and password are the same as those used to log in to the Student Portal. The parent can obtain these two pieces of information. This step must be completed before attempting to register for HCTB.

The secure Student SIS PIN is required to add a student to HCTB. The PIN is accessible through the SIS Parent Gateway. Parents who do not have access to the SIS Gateway will need to request the SIS Parent Gateway Letter, which contains the Student PIN from their child's school. Please contact aida.hadley@palmbeachschools.org if you do not have a SIS account.

Parents will be directed to the HCTB website to enroll in the application. Step-by-Step directions for downloading the mobile application and registering for HCTB can be found here and on Transportation Services' website.

Additional school resources are available on the Transportation Website and the HCTB District HUB site.

The District is excited about the ability of HCTB to provide more timely bus scheduling information and improve the overall transportation experience for parents, guardians, and students.

## ID BADGES

Students MUST wear their ID Badges every day per school district policy. Students may wear their own break-a-way school appropriate lanyard with their ID Badge. Students may not hang any items on their lanyards other than the ID badge (no toys, pins, etc.).

When visiting our school, please push the button located outside of the main entrance and state your name and purpose of the visit. Please have ID ready. Please do not hold the door for other visitors; each visitor must push the button individually. Thank you for your cooperation.

## STUDENT ABSENCES

It is important for students to attend school daily and be on time for school. If your child is absent, please notify your child's teacher through email with the reason for the absence. Excessive absences/tardies result in a loss of instructional time and impacts education. Students should be in their classroom and ready to learn at 8:00 a.m.

## DISMISSAL CHANGES

Dismissal changes should only occur in emergency situations. If you need to change the dismissal of your child, please notify the front office no later than 1:30 p.m.

# WASTE-FREE LUNCH TIPS

In an effort to reduce waste at our school, please send your child to school with reusable lunch bag/box for carrying a lunch. Also, please send refillable bottle for drinks but if you choose to use a single-serving container, please make sure it is recyclable. Consider placing sandwiches, muffins, etc. in reusable containers, instead of plastic bags along with reusable utensils.

# DRESS CODE POLICY - IMPORTANT

We have a mandatory dress code at Sunset Palms. ALL students are expected to be in dress code daily. No stripes, patterns. designs. Please see the details below.

The policy sets guidelines for students to create an atmosphere that fosters learning without fashion distractions and safety hazards. Students who DO NOT adhere to the dress code policy will receive an area of concern on the "Follows rules/routines/directions" section on the report card. Please contact the front office if you need assistance with obtaining dress code items. Shirts with logos may be purchased through our PTA. Other school dress code items may be purchased at any retail store.

Tops – Solid collared shirts (Any color, short sleeve or long sleeve, with or without the Sunset Palms logo). The Sunset Palms logo is preferred. No stripes, patterns or designs.

**Sweatshirts-** Solid color (free from decorations and writing) sweatshirts may be worn over the collared shirts in the classroom. Bottoms –Pants, capris, shorts, skirts, leggings and skorts (solid

khaki, navy, black). No stripes, patterns or designs.

**Uniform Jumpers** – Plain solid collared shirt underneath. Uniform Polo Dresses - Solid colors.

Jackets - Solid jackets (free from decorations and writing) may be worn over the collared shirt in the classroom. Other types of jackets may be worn to school and outside, but may NOT be worn in the classroom.

**Not permitted** – Midriff baring, short shorts, short skirts, short skorts, athletic shorts, flip flops, open toed, open heeled or platform shoes. Dress code clothes should not be cut, bedazzled, etc. Shoes must be closed toe and closed heel for safety reasons.

Fridays ONLY – Jeans may be worn with dress code top \*\*\*\*ID Badges MUST be worn daily.\*\*\*\*
