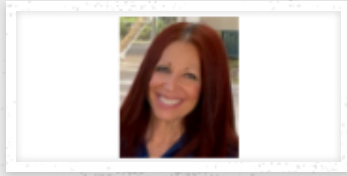

Ms. Rachel Caselle, Media Specialist

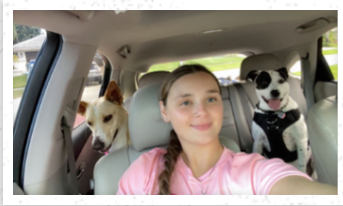

Mr. Carlos Pargas, 6th Social Studies

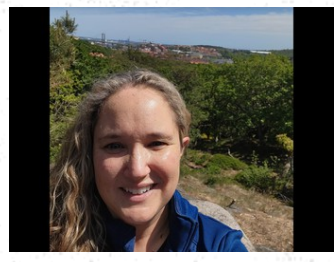
