## PM1 READING \& MATH SCORE RELEASE

Quick Steps: Accessing Scores in SIS Parent Gateway \& Family Portal Link

Log in to the SIS Parent Gateway. On the Home Screen, click on the Florida logo for each child to directly link to the state's Family Portal (no access code needed).


On the home screen of the SIS Parent Gateway, click on the student name to the left, then Child Info, then click on TEST - Local Assessment (to view scores weekly) or TEST - State Assessment for the final result reported by the state at the end of the state window (screenshot below).


Note: there is also link at the top "State FAST Assessment Information" for families to click on with helpful documents to understand FAST scores. They are also translated.

Award-winning educator Tova Fish-Rosenberg, creator of Names, Not Numbers said, "It's so important that the students listen to the survivors, research and ask questions." Tova and her husband made a visit to both Boca High School and Loggers' Run Middle School at the end of August.
