Our House Crest

The most important visual representation of each House is its House Crest. This is a specially designed Coat of Arms filled with symbols that speak to the values of the House. The crests should never be changed or altered. Preserving them builds House heritage!

The Knight

The open-visored helmet facing forward is typically reserved for the highest ranks of nobility. The knight is facing forward to symbolize having dreams and letting nothing stand in your way!

The Unicorn

A symbol of freedom, healing and beauty, the unicorn's powers are both magical and mystical. Known for its freedom and wild abandon, the unicorn is extremely difficult to tame.

Dreamer

Our name, "rèveur," comes from the French for "dreamer or idealist."



Crescent Moon

The crescent moon symbolizes new beginnings and the making of dreams into reality.

The moon also represents our symbolic animal, the wolf because when the moon comes out, the wolves come out!

WHAT'S HAPPENING AT LOGGERS' RUN!

NAMES, NOT NUMBERS HOLOCAUST EVENT

Award-winning educator Tova Fish-Rosenberg, creator of Names, Not Numbers said, "It's so important that the students listen to the survivors, research and ask questions." Tova and her husband made a visit to both Boca High School and Loggers' Run Middle School at the end of August.

Our Lumberjack students learned "interview techniques" by CBS12 anchorman/TEN network Ric Blackwell. Our students researched the Holocaust timeline, how to craft the questions and transition from Before the War ---> Beginning of WW2 ---> TO WW2 ---> TO Liberation/Aftermath.

The project involved the students engaging in dialogue with Tova, her husband Mr. Dov Rosenberg and Ric as they force relationships with them while also learning interviewing techniques, documentary film tools and editing skills through this process.
