



Why Choose Cambridge International?

- Rigorous international standards and frameworks comparable to any middle school program
- > Internationally benchmarked standards and assessments
- > Instructional delivery is spiraled and crosses content
- > Content is continuously connected to real world problems and solutions
- Instruction requires learners to engage in application of knowledge, higher order & critical thinking skills, and rigorous cooperative learning

How is a Cambridge classroom different?

- Students develop higher order thinking skills so that they can apply what they've learned.
- Students get to play an active role in the classroom; thinking critically, learning how to construct an argument and evaluate evidence, working independently, and collaborating with one another to bring a project to a successful outcome (and if it's not successful, they'll also learn lessons from reflecting on why that might be).
- Students will be encouraged to develop an international outlook, and become confident, global citizens.
- Students have to demonstrate understanding and the core knowledge of a subject, as well as think critically.
- Students will learn in a 1:1 digital environment in Cambridge classrooms.

International Curriculum & Standards


Identifies a comprehensive set of learning objectives in **English**, **Math**, **& Science** that is mapped to the Common Core State Standards & Florida Standards.
