# **CHOICE ACADEMIES**

#### **ACADEMY OF FINANCE**

The Academy of Finance was established in 1992 as one of the first Magnet Programs in Palm Beach County. It is one of several model programs established to promote educational excellence by the National Academy Foundation. NAF was founded by Sanford L. Weill, Chairman Emeritus of Citigroup Inc., as a partnership between business leaders and educators. This partnership links education and the community.

#### **ARMY JUNIOR ROTC**

This program provides courses in leadership theory, drill and ceremonies, first aid, map reading, land navigation and oral communication. The purpose is to develop good citizenship, patriotism, self-reliance and leadership. The emphasis is to promote responsiveness to constituted authority and develop skills in oral and written communication. An appreciation of the importance of physical fitness is included in this program.

#### EARLY CHILDHOOD TEACHER EDUCATION

This program provides an opportunity for high school students to prepare for entry into post-secondary education, as well as direct entry into a related child care career upon graduation. Early Childhood Professional Certification is available through the Florida Department of Children and Families.

#### IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

William T. Dwyer High School is an IB World School authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization. The IB Diploma Programme is an academically challenging and balanced program of education with final examinations that prepare students for success at the university level and life beyond. This is a challenging program that demands the best from highly motivated students.

#### ADDITIONAL ACADEMIC PROGRAMS OFFERED

#### **AICE DIPLOMA**

The Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Diploma is an international curriculum and examination system that emphasizes the value of broad and balanced study. Alongside in-depth understanding of a variety of subjects, students also need to master a broader range of skills critical for success in university study and employment.

# ADVANCEMENT VIA INDIVIDUAL DETERMINATION AVID ELECTIVE (4 years)

The AVID Elective is an academic system that identifies students in the middle who have a desire to go to college and have the willingness to work hard. AVID Elective students are usually the first in their families to attend a 4 year college, coming from groups that are traditionally underrepresented in higher education. Students in this academic elective class are encouraged to take honors and college courses.
