SUBJECT: FY22 GRADE 3 FLORIDA STANDARDS ASSESSMENT (FSA) ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS RESULTS:

ALL STUDENTS TESTED

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) has released the FY22 Grade 3 FSA English Language Arts (ELA) test results. This document summarizes today's release of data.

This school year, 14,135 students took the Grade 3 FSA ELA test, representing 98% of our enrolled Grade 3 students. This summary includes the percentage of students scoring Level 1 as well as students scoring Level 3 and above. While the percent of students scoring on grade level declined statewide (54% to 53%), Palm Beach County Schools maintained the performance from FY21 to FY22 with 54% of students on grade level. The percentage of students scoring at Level 1 increased from 25% to 26%.

A preliminary analysis of the results from the seven large urban districts and the State overall reveals the following for Grade 3 FSA ELA (in Table 1):

- From FY21 to FY22, the percent of District students scoring Level 3 or above remained unchanged while students scoring Level 1 increased by 1 percentage point.
- In FY22, when compared to the State and six other large urban districts:
 - The District has a higher percentage of students scoring Level 3 or above than three of the other large urban districts and was tied with two other large urban districts.
 - The District exceeded the State by one percentage point. This is the first time the District exceeded the State in 18 years.
 - o The District maintained the percent of students scoring Level 3 or above in FY22, while five of the six other large urban districts and the State declined between 1 and 2 percentage points.

 $^{^{1}}$ This summary is based on all students tested, not on the group of students used in the calculation of school grades.

 The District percent of students scoring Level 1 increased by 1 percentage point while four other large urban districts, and the State, increased between 2 and 3 percentage points.

Table 2 provides the percentage of students scoring Level 3 and above and the percentage of students scoring Level 1 by gender, race/ethnicity, ELL, ESE, and FRL status for Palm Beach County Schools. Overall results for individual schools are reported in the attachment. Percentages based on fewer than 10 students are excluded.

- For students scoring at Level 3 or higher from FY21 to FY22:
 - o ELL students show a substantial increase: ELL Male (3.9%), ELL Female (3.2%), and ELL All (3.6%).
 - Hispanic Males (2.5%) and White Females (3.1%) showed substantial gains.
 - Other groups showing modest gains included: Males overall (0.8%), ESE overall (1.1%), ESE Males (1.7%), and FRL Males (1.2%).
- For students scoring at Level 1, from FY21 to FY22:
 - o Black students tended to show the largest increase in percent scoring at Level 1 (2.8%) with the increase greater among Black Females (3.3%) than Black Males (2.5%).
 - Overall, Hispanic (<1%) and White (<1%) students tended to show smaller changes, although White Males showed an increase of 1.9%.
 - ESE Females tended to increase in Level 1 scores (1.8%) while ESE Males tended to decrease (-2.9%).
 - o FRL students showed increases overall (1.3%) and for both Females (1.1%) and Males (1.5%).

The attachment provides a school-level summary of today's data release. A total of 64 schools showed an increase in the percent of students scoring at Level 3 or above; 50 showed a decrease in the percent scoring at Level 1. Further, 19 schools showed a double digit increase in Level 3 or above and 10 showed a double digit decrease in level 1.

Schools will receive their results and use this information to meet individual student needs and for school improvement. District and regional staff will use the results to provide direction for improvement in curriculum and instruction. Additional analyses will be completed in the coming days.
