**SUBJECT: FY21 GRADE 3 FLORIDA STANDARDS ASSESSMENT (FSA) ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS RESULTS:
ALL STUDENTS TESTED**

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) has released the summary results of the FY21 Grade 3 FSA English Language Arts (ELA) test. This school year, 13,370 students took the Grade 3 FSA ELA test in the District representing 97% of our enrolled Grade 3 students.¹ This summary includes the percentage of students scoring Level 1 as well as students scoring Level 3 and above. While the percent of students scoring on grade level declined statewide (58% to 54%), Palm Beach County Schools maintained the performance from FY19 with 54% of students on Grade level despite the difficulties presented this school year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In FY16, with input from over 20,000 stakeholders, the District created a Strategic Plan with four Long Term Outcomes (LTO) including, possibly the most critical, reading on grade level by Grade 3, which ensures students are reading to learn. Each year, the Strategic Plan identifies an annual growth target for each LTO. With the release of the FY21 Grade 3 FSA ELA, the District fell short of the FY21 LTO target of 75% of students on Grade level, with the percentage remaining unchanged from FY19 at 54%. This was similar to the FY21 state percent of students scoring on grade level. The percentage of students scoring at Level 1 increased from 22% to 25%.

A preliminary analysis of the results from the seven large urban districts and the State overall reveals the following for Grade 3 FSA ELA (in Table 1):

- From FY19 to FY21, the percent of District students scoring Level 3 or above remained unchanged while students scoring Level 1 increased by 3 percentage points.
- In FY21, when compared to the State and six other large urban districts:
 - The District has a higher percentage of students scoring Level 3 or above than three of the other large urban districts and was similar to one other large urban district and the State.
 - The District maintained the percent of students scoring Level 3 or above in FY21, while five of the six other large urban districts and the State declined between 1 and 7 percentage points.
 - The District percent of students scoring Level 1 increased by 3 percentage points while all other large urban districts, including the State, increased between 2 and 5 percentage points.

¹ This summary is based on all students tested, not on the group of students used in the calculation of school grades.

Table 2 provides the percentage of students scoring Level 3 and above and the percentage of students scoring Level 1 by gender, race/ethnicity, ELL, ESE, and FRL status for Palm Beach County Schools. Overall results for individual schools are reported in the attachment. Percentages based on fewer than 10 students are excluded.

- For students scoring at Level 3 or higher from FY19 to FY21:
 - ELL students show a substantial decrease: ELL Male (-8.0%), ELL Female (-6.6%), and ELL - All (-7.4%)
 - Other groups that show a decrease of more than 1 percentage point include: White - All (-1.6%), ESE - All (-1.9%), Male - All (-2.2%), Hispanic Male (-2.4%), White Male (-3.0%), ESE Male (-3.3%), and FRL Male (-2.7%)
 - Black Females show the highest increase (2.0%)
- For students scoring at Level 1, from FY19 to FY21,
 - All categories show an increase of more than 1 percentage point
 - Female ELL students show the largest increase (9.3%)
 - All ELL categories show an increase of over 8 percentage points: ELL - All (9.2%), ELL Female (9.3%), ELL Male (8.9%)
 - Black Females show the lowest increase (1.1%)
