Incoming Grades 3-5

During Summer break, we recommend that you read at least five chapter books. You are required to complete one of the assignment options below on one book of your choosing. These books must be grade-appropriate. Don't be afraid to challenge yourself! You will be completing a book summary or Google Slides presentation. The template is located in the Summer Reading Google Classroom. Follow the directions below. Give your BEST effort! Have fun!

Option 1: Book Summary Assignment: Write a summary of the book you read using the Google Docs template included on the Summer Reading Google Classroom. Be sure to include characters, setting, genre, tone, and point of view.

Option 2: Google Slides Presentation: Create a presentation using the Google Slide template included in the Summer Reading Google Classroom.

Fiction Presentation:

Slide 1: Introduction - include your name, book title, author

Slide 2: major plot details

Slide 3: conflicts in the story

Slide 4: a main character list complete with physical & personality descriptions

Slide 5: specific details about the setting

Slide 6: your favorite quote or part of the book with an explanation of why it's your favorite.

Nonfiction Presentation:

Slide 1: Introduction - include your name, book title, author

Slide 2: Include the central idea and supporting details

Slide 3: Give two examples of text features (photographs, captions, maps, charts, etc.) you see in the text. How did they add to your understanding of the text?

Slide 4: What was the text structure of the text (description, problem & solution, sequential, cause & effect, and compare & contrast). How do you know?

Slide 5: Ten facts you learned from the book

Slide 6: A book review complete with 1-5 star rating and why

Students who submit their project to Google Classroom will receive 50 house points, and a donut party to celebrate!
