

## **Bak MSOA Eligibility and Code of Conduct**

BAK Student-Athlete: Student I.D #

- 1. All forms (1588, 1589, and FHSAA EL2 Physical) must be completed, signed, and approved by the Athletic Director prior to participation in try-outs, practices, or games. All students must have a birth certificate on file with the school.
- 2. All students must provide proof of insurance coverage (e.g, private or purchase "school" insurance) which provides medical coverage/reimbursement. The School District is NOT responsible for accidental interscholastic athletic injuries.
- 3. A student may participate for three consecutive years from the time the student successfully completes the fifth grade.
- 4. A student who has attained the age of 15 prior to September 1st of the current school year is ineligible to play, but may submit a hardship waiver to the school's Athletic Director to be considered for participation.
- 5. All student obligations must be met before participation in athletics/activities is allowed. This includes violation of the Bak MSOA Uniform Replacement Obligation.
- 6. All students must maintain a minimum 2.5 G.P.A. to be eligible to practice/play sports (no "F" grades\*).
- 7. Students with outstanding after school or lunch detention(s) must serve the detention(s) before practicing/competing.
- 8. Students who violate the Standards of Excellence as listed below, must complete the designated action to be eligible to practice/complete.
  - a) A student who fails an academic course must remediate the course (D or better).\*
  - b) A student who receives a D or F quarter grade in an art area course, must complete the 15 day probationary process.
  - c) A student who receives a 2 or 1 in conduct (on report card), must complete the 15 day probationary process.
  - d) A student who has excessive absences, must complete the 15 day probationary process.
  - e) A student who receives a discipline referral must complete the 15 day probationary process.
    - i) Level 2, 3, or 4 violations of The Student Code of Conduct, may result in the student being permanently removed from the team.
