SUBJECT: 11TH DAY ENROLLMENT COUNT SY2017-18 (FY2018)

The first official enrollment count of the 2017-18 school year was tabulated on Monday, August 28, 2017. The 11th Day Count is used primarily for school staffing purposes. The October FTE count will provide more stabilized enrollment data for planning and FTE purposes.

ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

Total PreK-12 enrollment for traditional district operated schools increased by 2,904 students from last year's 11th day enrollment. For all district schools, 11th day PreK-12 enrollment increased by 1,327 students. **Total SY2017-18 11th day PreK-12 enrollment was 193,972 students;** pre-kindergarten enrollment was 3,756 students. Table 1 summarizes the enrollment data.
