


- Application deadline is **January 26, 2024**. (If you have Dreyfoos School of the Arts or Boynton Beach Arts as any part of your application than your deadline is December 9, 2022).
- Results/Notification is March 28, 2024. You can also log-on to your application dashboard at that time.
  - I will also follow up with a welcome letter in early April and required documents to be signed.

# How to Apply:



#### **Parent Dashboard:**



Must have a Student ID.

Takes approximately 3 days once all paperwork has been uploaded.

# Important Reminders on the Application:

- Make sure your address is accurate: merges with PBC database
- Make sure you choose the right transportation option
- Make sure you are aware of the eligibility requirements and meet them
- "In House" programs could block your eligibility to apply to a program (if you do not see it on the drop down menu)
- Review your application status periodically
- You do NOT need to re-apply to academies each year. Once you are in, you're in!

# Important Reminders:

- Seats in Academies are assigned through the lottery. This is a true lottery and the school has no local influence or say over who gains admittance.
- The School District of Palm Beach County has unilateral control over all lottery placements at all PBC schools; Elementary, Middle & High.
- As much as we wish we could accept certain students, this
  is designed to prevent nepotism, and to promote equitable
  access to all students within our District.



## WILL I HAVE TRANSPORTATION?

Students who live outside the Choice Transportation Zone and are accepted to a Choice program MUST provide their own transportation to and from the:

1) School

or

2) Nearest school bus pick-up location within the transportation zone

To see current bus stops click on "Find my Bus" on the school district website



# Can my child enroll in two career academies?

Oftentimes students are interested in two academies.

A student can only receive ONE academy seat from the district.

If we have space, <u>and</u> the students met the criteria to be in a second academy, <u>and</u> the student has room on their schedule, we may enroll them in two.

Please communicate with your child's School Counselor if this is something you are interested in.



# Can my child be in CAAPP and an academy?

YES!

If your child meets the incoming academic requirements for CAAPP, they will be placed in that program.

The Academy class will take the place of the Elective on the CAAPP course sequence.






## ACADEMY EXPECTATIONS
