Uniform Policy

Uniforms are part of the required curriculum. Students will wear their complete medical uniform every Tuesday and during special activities. If a student is ABSENT on a Tuesday, the student will need to wear their uniform on the last school day of that week to receive credit. If a student FORGETS to wear their uniform on Tuesday, they CANNOT make it up at the end of the week. The same uniform will be worn for all three years while enrolled in the Pre-Medicine Academy.

All of the following must be met in order to receive credit for the uniform grade every Tuesday. No partial credit will be given.

Clothes: Dark blue scrubs with the IMS Pre-Medicine embroidered logo. They must be clean with no stains, rips or tears and hemmed properly. Information on how to order the scrubs will be attached. A white or navy plain tank top/undershirt may be worn underneath as an undershirt. This shirt will only be seen from the "V" neck area.

Jackets and sweaters worn during school must be able to completely open from the front so that the uniform is visible and can be graded. (Winter: A long sleeve plain white or navy shirt may be worn underneath scrubs in colder months.)

ID: MS Student/Photo ID is part of the medical uniform. **The ID must be intact and in good condition with full name and picture visible. (A temporary ID sticker **does not** give credit for the uniform grade.)

Shoes: Clean and closed sneakers are required. (Students need good traction for safety, moving and lifting techniques.)

Hair: Hair is to be pulled back away from the face with long styles worn in pony tails, braids or buns. Hair accessories should match the hair color or uniform color as much as possible. Long bangs can be clipped away from the face.

Jewelry: Earrings can only be **one stud** earring in each ear. A simple watch with a second hand is encouraged for skills practice. **No other visible jewelry is allowed.**

Personal: Deodorants are recommended; Perfumes should be avoided due to allergies, Nails should be short and clean. If nail polish is worn, it must be natural/neutral colors only.
