### What is an IB Education?

An IB education is unique because of its rigorous academic and individual standards. IB programs challenge students to excel not only in their studies but also in their personal growth. The IB Diploma Programme aims to inspire a lifelong quest for learning hallmarked by enthusiasm and empathy.

Entrance Requirement: Algebra I, 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA)

### How does a student achieve the IB Diploma (DP)?

- ★ IB subject examinations are scored on a scale of 1 to 7.
- ★ DP students must earn a total of at least 24 marks in all IB subject areas.
- ★ IB students take at least three (but not more than four) courses at the higher level (HL minimum 12 marks) and the others at the standard level (SL minimum 9 marks).
- ★ Higher level comprises 240 teaching hours. Standard level subjects take up 150 teaching hours.
- ★ Students do well on the Extended Essay and TOK for a potential 3 bonus points.
- ★ Students earn 150 CAS hours in which they engage in experiences and develop a project related to the concepts of creativity, activity, and service.

### How does the Diploma Programme (DP) prepare students for success in higher education and life in a global society?

The Diploma Programme is an academically challenging and balanced program of education assessed internally and externally with final examinations that prepare students aged 16 to 19 for success at university and life beyond. It has been designed to address the intellectual, social, emotional and physical well-being of students. The aim of all IB programs is to develop internationally minded people who, recognizing their common humanity and shared guardianship of the planet, help to create a better and more peaceful world. The program has gained recognition and respect from the world's leading universities.
