- ★ **The School District of Palm Beach County has unilateral control over all lottery placements at all PBC schools, Elementary, Middle & High.**
- ★ **As much as we wish we could accept all students, this is designed to prevent nepotism, and to promote equitable access to all students within our District.**

What Do I do now? Registration, Etc.

1st: You have accepted your choice seat in the online application

2nd: You may fill out the course selection google form provided by guidance, to be discussed next

3rd: The District will automatically assign choice students into new schools (when? As of now-May 6)

4th: Once they are attached to our school, then we may begin course selection

5th: During the summer, you may register for choice bus transportation

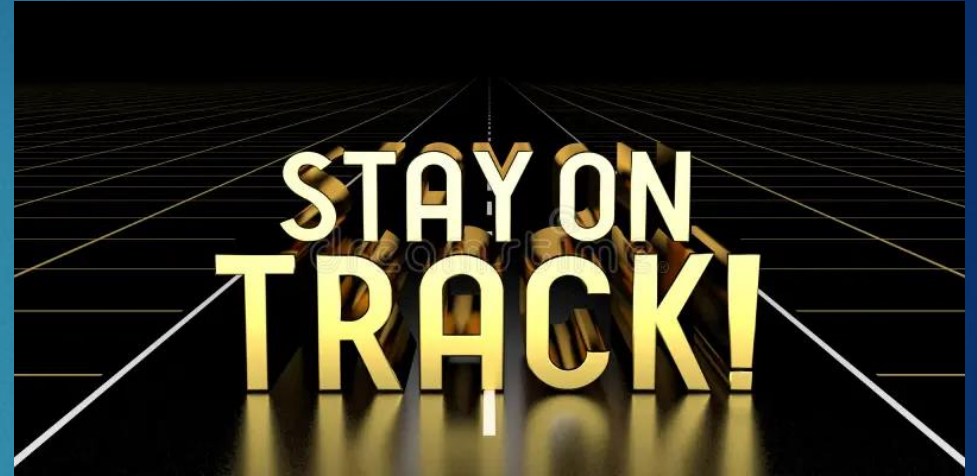

Key Points



- ▶ You do NOT need to re-apply to academies each year. Once you are in, you're in!
- ▶ We cannot create a schedule for your child until the district attaches their student ID to our school
- ▶ You will be unable to register for choice transportation until June/July -
- ▶ **Two Academies?** IE If you chose any of the performing arts as your second choice, and passed your audition, you may still join a second academy

- Keep in mind: Colleges will look at GPA, Test Scores, Rigor of your schedule, Extracurricular Activities (GET INVOLVED!!!)





COMMUNITY SERVICE

All students are required to complete 20 hours of community service before graduation.

These hours can accumulate beginning the summer going into 9th grade.

CORE CLASSES

Academy students: You will need to pick the course for you academy (see upcoming Academy slides).

Zoned students: English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Foreign Language (if applicable): Your current teacher will place you in the next level based on performance, ability, and test scores.

Here's what you should do:

1. Have a discussion with your teacher about your placement!
2. Check SIS requests to see what they placed you in. (See later slides)
